Plantation Island Resort Announces Phase 2 Development

Plantation Island Resort is pleased to announce an exciting new development which is the 2nd phase of our Redevelopment plans. Phase 2 includes the construction of a new Buffet Restaurant, Main Resort Pool, Bar and a Coffee Shop.

Dates of work: Construction will take place between 1 June 2020 until 31 July 2021.

Times of work: During this period, work will take place between Monday & Saturday each week and construction noise (machinery, vehicles etc) will take place between 10am and 5pm each day.

Scope of work: The project will begin with the Construction Team placing a fully secure hoarding fence around the construction site and demolishing 5 existing Bures (rooms 226 – 230). Once the site is ready, the Construction Team will then proceed with building new buildings for the Buffet Restaurant, Kitchen, Bar, Main Resort Pool and a Coffee Shop.

Disruption to Rooms: Plantation Island Resort has blocked 26 rooms closest to the construction site from guest use, so that no guest room will be located within 70 metres of the construction site. This is almost 3/4 the length of a football field.



Construction will take place within the red line.

Food & Beverage

Ol Copra Shed Restaurant

- · As construction noise (machinery, vehicles etc) will not begin until 10am each day, buffet breakfast at the Ol Copra Shed Restaurant will not be impacted whatsoever
- Lunch takes place at Tavola Restaurant & Bar which is hundreds of meters away from the construction site
- · Kids Buffet dinner begins at 5:30pm, after the construction work has been completed for the day.
- · Adults Dinner starts at 6pm, well after the construction work stops
- · Black Coral Grill (A la carte)
- Opens for dinner service at 6pm each day, well after the construction has been completed.

Snack Bar

- · Will unfortunately be impacted as it is near the construction site, however it will be relocated to the Ol Copra Shed Restaurant building
- This is a grab & go, light & easy meal venue and therefore most people do not sit at the outlet to eat & drink

Mini Mart

 Will operate in its existing location (near the construction site), however we will also be implementing a mobile Mini Mart service along the beachfront in front of the 300's rooms

Coco Hut

- · Will operate in its existing location (near the construction site) as normal.
- · This is also a grab & go outlet and very few people sit at the outlet to eat & drink.

Changes to Activities

Key guest activities will be relocated to locations far away from construction site. Both the Activities Bure (where guests get pool towels, snorkeling gear, life jackets, non-motorized watersports) and the Inflatable Water Parks will be relocated further down the beach, to ensure they are far away from the construction site.



Compensation

Plantation Island Resort will be implementing several strategies to minimize any disturbance to guests during their holiday. This includes ensuring that no guest paying normal rates will have to stay within 70 metres of the construction site, relocating activities to areas far away from the construction site and ensuring that there will be minimal impact on the food & beverage experience during a holiday. Therefore, Plantation Island Resort will not be offering any compensation to guests during this period.
